A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE DOWNTOWN SPECIFIC PLAN TO PERMIT MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT, MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT, AND ESTABLISH ASSOCIATED DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS WITHIN THE NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERICAL DISTRICT OF A MULTI-FAMILY DEVELOPMENT CONSISTING OF 13 RESIDENTIAL UNITS ON A VACANT 0.66 ACRE PARCEL LOCATED AT 4019 MISSION INN AVENUE, SITUATED ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF MISSION INN AVENUE AND CHESTNUT STREET.

WHEREAS, an application was submitted in connection with the construction of 13 residential units on a vacant 0.66 acre parcel located at 4019 Mission Inn Avenue, situated on the northwest corner of Mission Inn Avenue and Chestnut Street ("Project"), designated as Planning Case No. P17-0761, to amend the Downtown Specific Plan to permit multi-family residential development, mixed use development, and establish associated development standards within the Neighborhood Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2018, the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside held a public hearing to consider the proposed amendment to the Downtown Specific Plan and recommended to the City Council that the amendment be approved; and

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2018, the City Council and advertised and held a public hearing to consider Planning Case No. P17-0761; and

WHEREAS, the City Council received and considered the staff report and recommendation of the Planning Commission and all other testimony, both written and oral, present at the public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: Incorporating the findings set forth above and in the documents and reports for Planning Case No. P17-0761, the Downtown Specific Plan is hereby amended to permit multifamily residential development, mixed use development, and establish associated development standards within the Neighborhood Commercial District, which proposed amendments are shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

1	Section 2: The amendment adopted by this resolution shall be integrated into the adopted
2	Downtown Specific Plan documents and shall be noted on the appropriate specific plan and general
3	plan maps previously adopted by the City Council as appropriate.
4	Section 3: It is the independent judgment of the City Council of the City of Riverside that
5	this amendment to the Downtown Specific Plan will not have a significant effect on the environment
6	with the adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration and City Council hereby adopts the same.
