## **BACKGROUND**


On April 11, 2017, City Council:

- 1. Approved Third Street Grade Separation as the top priority grade separation; and
- 2. Directed Public Works to issue a Request for Proposals to complete the preliminary engineering.

## **PROJECT STATUS**

- 1. April 12, 2018 Public Works issued RFP No. 1717.
- 2. May 29, 2018 Public Works received 6 proposals.
- 3. July 2, 2018 Top three consultants interviewed/ranked.
- 4. Public Works is negotiating Project scope and fee and will return by October to seek Council approval for consultant agreement.
