On April 11, 2017, City Council:

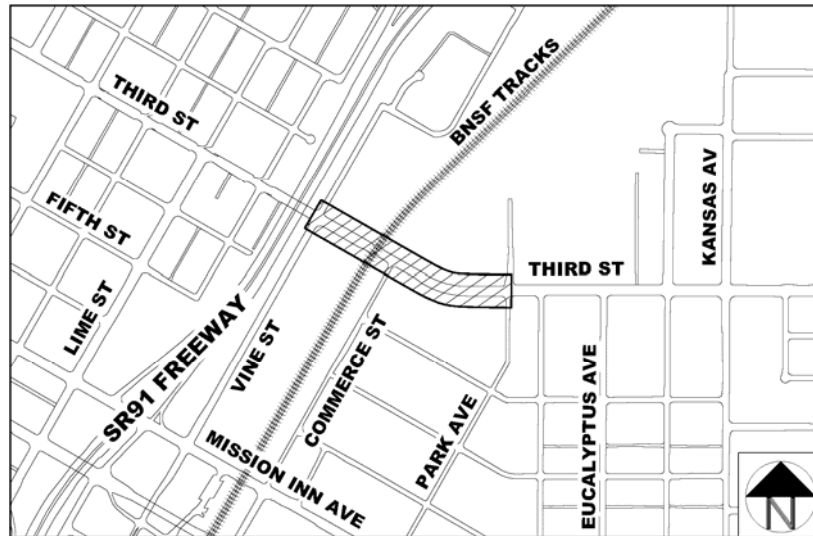
1. Approved Third Street Grade Separation as the top priority grade separation; and
2. Directed Public Works to issue a Request for Proposals to complete the preliminary engineering.

PROJECT STATUS

1. April 12, 2018 - Public Works issued RFP No. 1717.
2. May 29, 2018 - Public Works received 6 proposals.
3. July 2, 2018 - Top three consultants interviewed/ranked.
4. Public Works is negotiating Project scope and fee and will return by October to seek Council approval for consultant agreement.

RECOMMENDATIONS
