ANNUAL REVIEW OF CODE OF ETHICS AND CONDUCT

Following a report from City Clerk Nicol, conduct of the annual review of the Code of Ethics and Conduct as required by Riverside Municipal Code Section 2.78.110, and consideration of comments received from the Board of Public Utilities, it was moved by Member Tucker and seconded by Member Stahovich to recommend to the City Council Governmental Affairs Committee that no further revisions are needed at this time. Motion carried unanimously.

REPORT ON GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

City Clerk Nicol reported that on June 6, 2018, the Governmental Affairs Committee unanimously recommended that the City Council amend Riverside Municipal Code Chapter 2.78 to further define the scope of examination of witnesses and presentation of rebuttal evidence as recommended by the Board

of Ethics. On July 24, 2018, the City Council unanimously introduced the ordinance to amend the Code of Ethics as recommended by the Board of Ethics and Governmental Affairs Committee. The second reading of the ordinance will occur on August 14, 2018.
