What is TCC

- Transformative Climate Communities Grant (TCC)
 - State of California
 - Dollars produced from capping pollution and issuing trade credits above the cap
- Grants of \$30-\$40 million each for local communities

WHAT IS TCC?

- **GOALS:**
 - *Producing public health and environmental benefits through the reduction emissions from sources of air pollution within a Project Area.*
 - Eastside and Downtown

Health and Well Being:

Community Gardens/Park Improvements (access/small projects)

University Avenue Specific Plan*

- h. “Enhanced” Bus Stops (in Eastside Neighborhood, Restorative Growth, Chicago/Linden Plans)

Potential Projects

Chicago/Linden Strategic Plan*

- Patterson Park Improvements
 - Lighting
 - Open cul-de-sac
- Alley Improvements
 - Paving
 - Lighting
 - Art
- 7th and Chicago (Entrada) Project (\$17.5 million)



Potential Projects

Parks Master Plan

– Lincoln, Bobby Bonds, Patterson

- Bonds – Fitness Equipment;
- Patterson – “Football” (soccer) Field;
- Swim Complex Shade (solar) structures;
- Patterson – Community Center.



Potential Projects

Eastside Neighborhood Plan

- Art Alleyways (also Chicago-Linden);
- Crosswalk Improvements.



Potential Projects

County Workforce Development Plan

- Provide intensive career services to dislocated workers .
 - Establish or expand workforce training programs with career pathways for low income residents with an emphasis on clean energy jobs.
 - Adopt community workforce agreements to place low-income workers.
 - Establish programs to ensure placement and retention in quality jobs.
- Connect job training opportunities and local labor market demand.
