The Public Safety Division of the City Attorney's Office – in partnership with Police, Fire, Code Enforcement and the community - works to combat actions that impact the quality of life in Riverside's neighborhoods and support our City public safety partners.

- Received 344 neighborhood problems to tackle. 72% of the assignments were fully solved and closed out.
- Attended 50 community meetings.

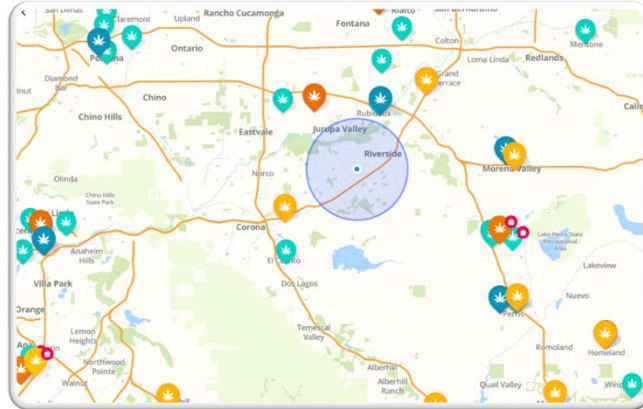
PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS FISCAL YEAR 2017-18

- Shut down
 - 12 marijuana dispensaries;
 - 8 substandard properties through court-ordered receiverships or alternative means;
 - 2 unpermitted nightclubs; and
 - 7 illicit massage parlors.

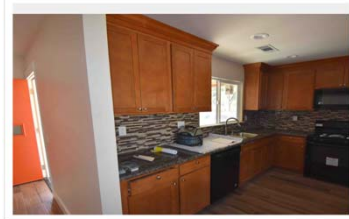

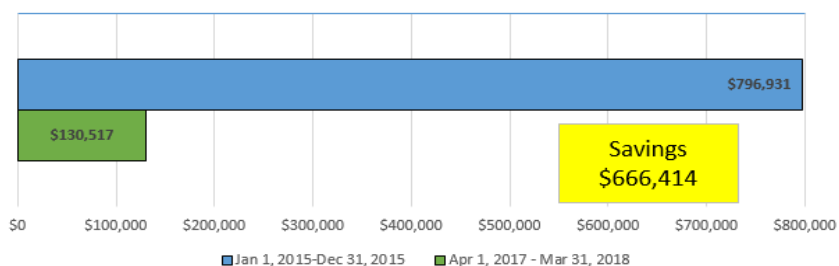
PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS REVENUE FOR GENERAL FUND

- The Division collected **\$479,158.92** from actions involving rehabilitation agreements, receiverships, and marijuana dispensary enforcement.

The Division takes great pride in defending lawsuits filed against the City and individual RPD officers alleging civil rights violations. In addition, attorneys are consulted and train on the state of the law to reduce the risk of litigation, while ensuring that the men and women of the RPD are well-equipped to protect themselves and the City's neighborhoods.

- Combined General Fund Contribution for fiscal year 2017-18:
 - Collections: \$479,158
 - Outside Counsel Savings: \$666,414
 - Total: **\$1,145,572**

PUBLIC SAFETY DIVISION HIGHLIGHTS REVENUE FOR GENERAL FUND

- No new police civil rights cases sent to outside counsel in past 2 fiscal years.
- Time-intensive litigation and high exposure largely due to injuries and provision for recovery of plaintiffs' attorneys fees.

Depositions in Calhoun v. City



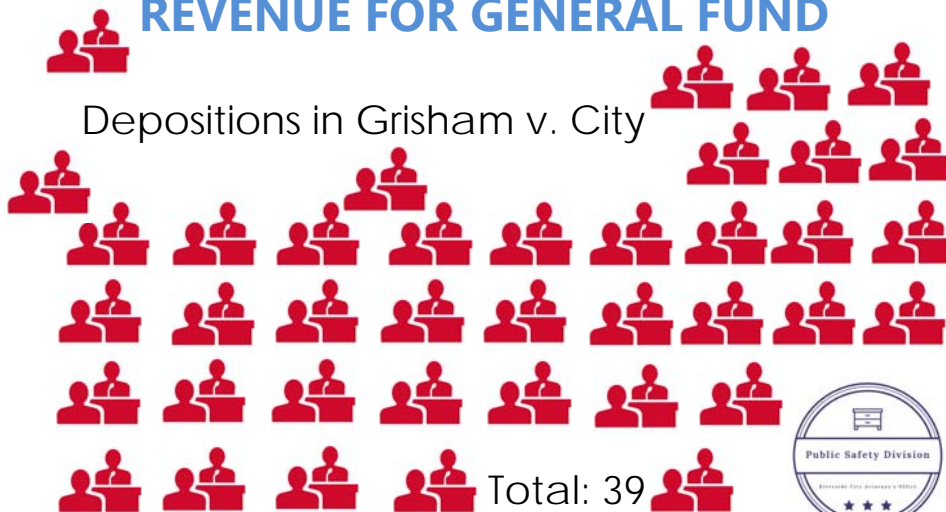
