

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,  
3 AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE  
4 TRANSFORMATIVE CLIMATE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM  
5 ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF  
6 CONSERVATION AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF ALL  
7 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS BY THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS  
8 DESIGNEE.

9 WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Conservation (“Grantor”), through the  
10 Strategic Growth Council, has heretofore invited public agencies, including the City of Riverside  
11 (“City”) to submit applications to the Grantor for the Fiscal Year 2018 Transformative Climate  
12 Communities Program (“Grant”) via a Notice of Funding Availability (“Notice”) dated August 15,  
13 2018; and

14 WHEREAS, in response to this Notice, the City wishes to apply to the Grantor for, and  
15 receive an allocation of, the Grant funds; and

16 WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in the best interests to submit an application  
17 for Grant funds for clean energy, smart growth, and affordable housing projects in and around the  
18 City’s Eastside Neighborhood; and

19 WHEREAS, the City shall submit an application to the Grantor to participate in the Grant  
20 program and for an allocation of funds of approximately Twenty-Three Million Dollars  
21 (\$23,000,000) for clean energy, smart growth, and affordable housing projects in and around the  
22 City’s Eastside Neighborhood; and

23 WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of such Grant; and

24 WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to conform to each of the terms, conditions, and  
25 limitations imposed upon any such Grant to the City; and

26 WHEREAS, the City understands that the Grantor must approve said application and will  
27 require the City to execute a Funding Agreement and other necessary documents upon approval.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
California, as follows:

Section 1: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an application for Grant funds for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by the State of California Department of Conservation through its Strategic Growth Council.

Section 2: The City of Riverside hereby agrees to comply with each and all of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed by the Grantor upon said Grant, and the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute any applications, agreements, assurance, extensions, amendments or other documents as may be necessary in connection with acceptance and implementation of said Grant as may be required by the Grantor.
