

OVERVIEW


- 1. Annual report of the City's Workers' Compensation claims activities and costs through June 30, 2018;
- 2. The W/C Division currently handles 700+ open claims (approximately 400 are open lifetime medical claims);
- 3. Each adjustor (currently 2) handles approximately 170 Indemnity claims each; and
- 4. W/C Assistants are currently handling a case load of 200 claims consisting of lifetime medical and medical only claims.


