

About Alzheimer's Disease

- Causes problems with memory, thinking, and behavior. Not a normal part of aging process.
- 3rd leading cause of death in California and 6th in the US.
- 5.7 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's.
- By 2050, this number is projected to rise to nearly 14 million.
- Someone in the US develops Alzheimer's every 65 seconds.
- 1 in 3 seniors die with a form of dementia.







National Alzheimer's Awareness Month

- In 1983, President Reagan designated November as National Alzheimer's Awareness Month.
- At the time fewer than 2 million Americans had Alzheimer's

Today the number of people has soared to nearly 5.7 million.

Families and Caregivers

- Dementia caregivers report substantial emotional, financial, and physical difficulties.
 This is two times more than other caregivers.
- Approximately two-thirds of caregivers are women.
- Of the total lifetime cost of caring for someone with dementia, 70% is borne by families.








