

PLANNING COMMISSION ANNUAL UPDATE - 2017

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GENERAL OVERVIEW

- 1. The Planning Commission continues to consider high quality projects reflective of the on-going commitment of the Commission and Staff to implement the goals and policies of the City's General Plan 2025, Municipal Code, and Citywide Sign & Design Guidelines.
- 2. In 2017, Planning Commission considered a total of 50 projects, two projects less than in 2016.
- 3. There has been a reduction in the Commission activity level due to implementation of the "Streamline Riverside" Code Amendment.



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EXAMPLES OF HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

- 1. <u>General Plan 2025 Amendment</u>: 2014-2021 Housing Element Update (Citywide)
- Canyon Springs Healthcare Campus Specific Plan and EIR: Hospital, medical office buildings, and Senior Housing (Ward 2 -Canyon Springs Parkway and Eucalyptus Avenue)
- 3. Shopping Center Expansion: 9,520 square foot multi-tenant commercial building (Ward 6 Park Sierra Drive and Magnolia Avenue)



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EXAMPLES OF HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

- Madison Plaza Expansion: 24 Hour Fitness, Starbucks Drive Thru Restaurant, Multi-tenant Commercial building and Parking lot modifications (Ward 3 -Madison Avenue at 91 Freeway on Ramp)
- 5. <u>Luv2Play:</u> Indoor playground at Stater Bros Shopping Center (Ward 7 -La Sierra and Hole Avenues)
- 6. <u>Planned Residential Development:</u> 54 detached single family residences (Ward 5 9170 Indiana Avenue)



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EXAMPLES OF HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS

- 7. <u>Jack-In-The-Box:</u> A 1,857 square foot fast food drive thru restaurant (Ward 4 Alessandro Boulevard and Barton Street)
- 8. <u>Downtown Main + Nine:</u> Mixed use project consisting of 36 residential units and multi tenant commercial lease spaces (Ward 1 Main and Ninth Streets)
- 9. <u>Downtown Stalder Plaza:</u> Mixed use project consisting of 165 residential units and multi tenant commercial lease spaces (Ward 1 Mission Inn Avenue and Market Street)
