BACKGROUND

1. The **Riverside Police Department (RPD)** obtains possession of bicycles under three circumstances:
 - a. **Safe keeping** - when the rider/owner is arrested.
 - b. **Found property** - bikes are reported as found and have no known owner.
 - c. **Evidence** – bikes that are part of an investigation.
2. If unclaimed, after **proper notifications**, there are procedures in place to dispose of the bikes.

BACKGROUND

1. **120 bikes** fall into these circumstances annually.
2. Traditionally, bikes are turned over to Propertyroom.com for auction, for a **50/50 split of bike sale proceeds**.
3. **\$550** returns to the general fund annually (average \$4.58 per bike).
4. **Process is cumbersome**, as Propertyroom.com has become increasingly selective about what they will accept.

COMPELLING CAUSE

1. US Vets and Camp Anza residents need bikes to get to and from job interviews, work, and medical appointments.
2. Research suggests that riding a bike helps Veterans recover from Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).

RIDE 2 RECOVERY - DBA PROJECT HERO

1. Ride 2 Recovery – DBA Project Hero is a **national non-profit** organization.
2. Committed to helping veterans and first responders, specifically those with:
 - a) Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
 - b) Traumatic brain injury (TBI)

BIKES4VETS PROGRAM

1. The proposed program will discontinue the Propertyroom.com relationship, and instead enter into a new relationship with Project Hero.
2. Ride 2 Recovery- DBA Project Hero shall assemble safe bicycles for further charitable distribution within the City of Riverside.

BIKES4VETS DISTRIBUTION

1. Priority will be given as follows:
 - a) Formerly homeless veterans residing in subsidized housing, regardless of Veterans Affairs disability status.
 - b) Veterans with a service connected disability rating from Veterans Affairs.
 - c) All other military personnel, veterans and members of the National Guard.
 - d) Immediate family members of above listed veterans.

BIKES4VETS DISTRIBUTION (CONT.)

2. Should any bikes remain, Project Hero will keep the bikes for Ride 2 Recovery – DBA Project Hero cycling classes and events.
3. Children's bikes that Project Hero is unable to distribute, will be provided to Riverside's youth, in accordance with a carefully crafted RPD operational policy, through the Riverside Police Foundation.

BIKES4VETS PROGRAM

1. Ride 2 Recovery – DBA Project Hero will provide recurring classes and guided rides to recipients under the Bikes4Vets program.
2. Ride 2 Recovery – DBA Project Hero will sign a receipt for each bike and will provide a quarterly report to RPD.

FISCAL IMPACT

Bikes4Vets will result in an estimated loss of approximately \$550.00 annually to the City's General Fund.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. Approve the MOU between the City and Ride 2 Recovery – DBA Project Hero for the “Bikes4Vets” Bicycle Collaboration.
2. Authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute the MOU with Ride 2 Recovery - DBA Project Hero, including making minor and non-substantive changes.
