**SUBJECT: UPDATE ON THE PARK MASTER PLAN PROJECT**

**ISSUE:**

Receive an update on the Park Master Plan project.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

**BACKGROUND:**

On Monday, March 13, 2017, the Park and Recreation Commission was presented with the Park Master Plan project. Per their request, an oral update will be provided at every Park and Recreation Commission meeting until the Park Master Plan is adopted.

**DISCUSSION:**

Currently the consultant team, RJM, Inc. continues working to develop the draft Master Plan. The draft Master Plan will include service level recommendations, Capital Improvement Program, Operational and Maintenance Plan, recommended updates to the City's General Plan and a Financial Strategy Plan. A few of the sections have been received and are currently being reviewed by staff. The draft Master Plan is anticipated to be presented to the Park and Recreation Commission in early 2019.
