SUBJECT: DETERMINE WHETHER COMMISSIONER TODD ROUNDS' ABSENCE FROM

THE PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2018, SHOULD BE RECORDED AS AN EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED ABSENCE

#### ISSUE:

Determine whether Commissioner Todd Round's absence on September 17, 2018, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Park and Recreation Commission determine if Commissioner Round's absence from the Park and Recreation Commission meeting on September 17, 2018, be excused or unexcused.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On May 6, 2014, the City Council approved the recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states that Board/Commission members should provide 24 hours advance notice in the event of an absence and that the Board/Commission may exercise its discretion to excuse absences.

# **DISCUSSION:**

Commissioner Todd Rounds was not present at the Commission meeting on September 17, 2018. On September 17, 2018, Staff received advanced notification from Commissioner Rounds about his absence.
