## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the City Council appoint Councilmember Melendrez to serve in place of Councilmember Mac Arthur on the Development Committee to discuss a proposed two-story mixed-use development on Successor Agency-owned vacant land located at 1910 University Avenue and a two-level parking structure development on Successor Agency-owned vacant land located at 3870 Ottawa Avenue.

## **BACKGROUND:**


