SUBJECT: WATER HIGHLIGHTS – OCTOBER 2018

Domestic water production for the month of October 2018 totaled 6,250 acre-feet (2,037 million gallons), with the following resource mix:

- Bunker Hill Basin: 73%
- Riverside Basin: 27%
- Purchased Water: 0%

Peak water usage was 71 million gallons per day (mgd) and occurred on October 2, 2018.

Under the Cooperative Agreement for Water Production and Conveyance with Western Municipal Water District, 665 AF of potable water and 124 AF of irrigation water was delivered to WMWD.

There were no significant events for the water system in October 2018.




