## 2. Board Chair Report

Board Chair Hughes welcomed the newest Board member representing Ward 4, Deb Whitney. The Museum received a letter granting reaccreditation from the American Alliance of Museums (AAM).

## 3. Riverside Museum Associates (RMA)

RMA President Robin Whittington reported that the RMA will be on a year-long journey to redefine the organization and follow the Museum's mission. The RMA Multicultural Council received an \$800 grant from the City of Riverside for their Annual Day of Inclusion, which will focus on the immigration and migration in the Inland Empire. The RMA will host a yard sale in October with surplus Museum items, pending City Council approval. The Chinese Moon Festival will be held Sunday, September 23, from 6-8 p.m.

## 4. Harada House Foundation (HHF)

HHF Vice-President Elio Palacios reported that the HHF is celebrating one year with taxexempt status. The HHF is close to finalizing the MOU with the Museum department; the document is currently under City review.

5. Director's update regarding administration and budget, staffing, collections, facilities, main museum renovation, exhibitions and programs, and community engagement

In addition to the written report, Director Peterson reported that the Museum is required to submit an interim report in three years to the AAM accreditation commission. The new Curator of Historic Structures will begin on September 24. The Curator of Natural History position has been posted online. Termite fumigation at the Heritage House will take place August 14th-16th. The Tlatilco exhibition closes at the Riverside Art Museum on December 30. Two of three advisory group meetings have been held. The Harada Centenary Day event is scheduled for Monday, September 17.
