SUBJECT: SELECTION OF APPLICANTS FOR INTERVIEW FOR COMMUNITY POLICE REVIEW COMMISSION WARDS 4 AND 6 VACANCIES

ISSUE:

Review applications for the Community Police Review Commission Wards 4 and 6 seats and select applicants for interview.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee:

- 1. Review Community Police Review Commission applications for Wards 4 and 6 and select those for interview to fill vacancies through March 1, 2021; and
- 2. Direct the City Clerk to schedule interviews with the Mayor and Councilmembers to add additional names for interview, if desired.

BACKGROUND:

On October 26 and December 3, 2018, the City Clerk received the resignations of James Kurkoske and William V. Timmons from the Wards 4 and 6 seats on the Community Police Review Commission effective January 1, 2019, and December 31, 2018, respectively. Both terms expire on March 1, 2021. There are eight applications on file for the Ward 4 seat and four applications for the Ward 6 seat.

Pursuant to the City Council Meeting Rules, the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee reviews the applications and selects those for interview with the Mayor and City Council as individuals to add additional names for interview, if desired.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Costs for recruitment and selection of board and commission members are budgeted annually in the City Clerk's Department budget.
