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

I am writing in response to the current opening on the Riverside Police Review Commission, Ward 4. I currently live in Ward 4 and submit this application and resume for consideration of appointment to the open position. Having been a resident of both the County of Riverside and City of Riverside for most of my entire life, I am concerned about quality of life issues and believe police/community relations are of great importance. I believe the Police Review Commission plays an important role in making sure the public has confidence in our police department and I would love the opportunity to be a part of this process. I believe you will find my qualifications and experience may compliment the current board. Thank you for your consideration of my application.





OBJECTIVE

I moved to the City of Riverside when I was eight years old and attended Jackson Elementary School, Chemawa Middle School and graduated from Arlington High School in 1981. I enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps a few years later and after my enlistment began a career with the Riverside County Sheriff's Department. I moved back to the City of Riverside in 1995 and currently reside in Ward 4. I am applying for consideration of the open Community Police Review Commission position. I believe my law enforcement career with so many varied assignments would bring a good variety of experiences to the board.

CAREER SUMMARY

During my law enforcement career, I developed comprehensive skills in the Administration of Justice which include: investigation of complex criminal cases; preparation, supervision and execution of search warrants and arrest warrants, court orders and other legal process; supervision and participation in field investigations; preparation and filing of criminal cases for court; assisting in the training of new deputies; effective leadership and hands-on problem solving ability. I have attended the Riverside Community College and have obtained approximately 32 units, mainly in general education and the administration of justice.

After retirement from law enforcement I have worked for approximately two years in the guest services arena with a restaurant company (Ovation Brands) and now Soboba Casino. I have enjoyed the transition to civilian life and enjoy the guest services industry. I currently manage a team of approximately 25 security officers/supervisors to ensure the safety of our casino guests and assets.

During my twenty-six-year law enforcement career I served approximately eight years as a patrol deputy/officer and approximately seventeen years as an investigator. During my time as a patrol officer I conducted investigations of all types of crimes from petty theft to murder and met with and interviewed persons in all walks of life. My investigative experience includes investigations of all types of general crimes, narcotics investigations, complex public corruption and fraud investigation with the last seven years being with the Riverside County District Attorney Bureau of Investigations-Professional Standards Bureau/Public Integrity Unit (P.I.U.). My duties while assigned to the P.I.U. included investigating complaints of criminal activity involving public officials and elected officials related to violations of various penal codes, government codes and elections codes. Additionally, I assisted in conducting internal affairs investigations and some officer misconduct investigations. The majority of these investigations dealt with sensitive matters related to public figures or public officials. At times this arena required innovative

approaches to the investigations due to the diverse nature of persons involved with these types of investigations. I have the ability to interact with, converse with and interview persons of all types of backgrounds regardless of their social, professional or economic background.

During my tenure with Ovation Brands as Manager-Internal Audits/Loss Prevention I was responsible for overseeing 108 stores in the western region of the country where I worked under the direction of the Director-Internal Audits/Loss Prevention.
