SUBJECT: AGRICULTURAL WATER RATES TASK FORCE OPEN DISCUSSION ON: CONTINUED DISCUSSION, EVALUATION, DEVELOPMENT AND SYSTEMATIC REVIEW OF WA-AG RATE PROPOSAL VERSION 17

ISSUE:

Open discussion to continue the discussion, evaluation and systematic review of the WA-Ag rate proposal version 17.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force continues the discussion, evaluation and systematic review of the WA-Ag rate proposal version 17.

BACKGROUND:

Open discussion was part of the original Work Plan approved by the RPU Board. The final rate recommendations will be presented to City Council in mid-2019.

DISCUSSION:

Open discussion is an important part of the rate development process. At the November 14, 2018 meeting, the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force was presented with, and discussed, the WA-Ag rate proposal (version 14). This rate proposal continues to be developed and thus requires more discussion as it continues to evolve. The WA-Ag rate proposal attached (version 17) reflects revisions based on discussions that took place at the November meeting. Chair Wilson will systematically review WA-Ag rate proposal version 17 using the attached presentation to obtain consensus on individual aspects of the proposal framework.
