Students started classes on January 6, 1919 because of the Spanish Flu epidemic



A little history on Liberty Elementary:

- In 1875 a 1-room schoolhouse was built on Miller Street.
- In 1891 a second school (4 rooms) was built where Arlington Park is today, it was named 'Magnolia School'.
- This new school drew students from the Santa Ana River area, Mocking Bird Canyon and from areas near La Sierra.
- By 1903 Magnolia School began double sessions morning and afternoon, this was to house all the children.
- In 1907 Riverside became RUSD and Magnolia School became part of Riverside Unified and the school was changed to Arlington School.
- In 1916 the PTA organized a committee, met with the School Board, it was agreed that a new school was needed and 5 acres were purchased (9631 Hayes St.).
