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### BACKGROUND EXISTING HUNTER SUBSTATION

#### **Existing Hunter Substation**

- 1. Located on Chicago Ave., north of Marlborough Ave
- 2. Serves 4,700 customers
- 3. Built in 1960 (One of the oldest substations)



### BACKGROUND EXISTING HUNTER SUBSTATION

- 1. High risk of equipment failure in service
- 2. (Circuit breaker 52-3)
- 3. Seismic deficiencies
- 4. Operational limitation
- 5. Near maximum capacity
- 6. Substation exceeded its design life

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## BACKGROUND EXISTING HUNTER SUBSTATION



RPU is planning on replacing Hunter Substation to ensure reliable and safe electrical service



### DISCUSSION LAND ACQUISITION

- 1. Existing substation space limitation
- 2. Limited capacity in nearby substations
- 3. Board approved purchase of adjacent land in February 12, 2018
- 4. The new substation will be constructed on the newly acquired land





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### DISCUSSION NEW SUBSTATION

- 1. Four sub-transmission lines
- 2. Four substation transformers
- 3. 16 distribution circuits
- 4. Total planned capacity of 125MVA

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#### DISCUSSION **IMPROVEMENT**

- 1. Hunter Substation will help Riverside Public Utilities meet existing power demands, future development in the area, and maintain power reliability
- 2. Project will help maintain a stable level of electric service in the area during the event of a major power shutdown or service disruption

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### **DISCUSSION PROJECT PHASES**

- **Phase 1**: Complete CEQA, preliminary design and prepare EPC bid package by August 2019
- **Phase 2**: Award contract by November of 2019
- **Phase 3**: Commissioned by December of 2022
