			 Add a City Auditor as an additional Charter officer appointed by the City Council, with the powers and duties of the City Auditor set by ordinance. The following are examples of such powers and duties: The City Auditor shall be a certified public accountant, a certified internal auditor, or have such other or additional qualifications as the City Council may establish by resolution. The City Auditor shall set the qualifications for subordinate staff. By March 1st each year, the City Auditor shall submit an annual audit plan to the City Council for approval. The annual audit plan may be amended during the year with the approval of the City Council. The City Council may, by resolution, authorize a committee, charter officer, or an individual Councilmember with respect to the Councilmember's own office, to request additional audits. Audits shall be conducted in accordance with standards as prescribed by City Council resolution. The City Auditor shall prepare a written report of the results of each audit conducted and will be responsible for retaining a copy as a permanent record. The City Council may prescribe by resolution the manner of report preparation and presentation.
