**SUBJECT: DETERMINE WHETHER COMMISSIONER JENNIFER HUMPHREY'S ABSENCE FROM THE PARK AND RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING ON DECEMBER 17, 2018 SHOULD BE RECORDED AS AN EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED ABSENCE**

## **ISSUE:**

Determine whether Commissioner Jennifer Humphrey's absence on December 17, 2018, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Park and Recreation Commission determine if Commissioner Humphrey's absence from the Park and Recreation Commission meeting on December 17, 2018, be excused or unexcused.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On July 26, 2016, City Council approved the recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states, "Board/Commission members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter."

## **DISCUSSION:**

Commissioner Humphrey was not present at the Commission meeting on December 17, 2018; prior notice was not given. On the evening of December 17, 2018, Commissioner Humphrey emailed her designee and notified her of absence.
