**SUBJECT: SECURITY CAMERA EQUIPMENT, INSTALLATION, AND LICENSING COSTS**

## **ISSUE:**

Receive an update on security camera equipment, installation, and licensing costs.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board of Library Trustees receive and file an update on security camera equipment, installation, and licensing costs.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On October 22, 2018, the Board of Library Trustees requested a report on costs associated with security camera equipment, installation, and licensing.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The Library currently has cameras installed at all library locations. These cameras capture images in critical areas in and around the libraries. Cameras have been installed over time and the associated costs have varied.

The following table includes all costs associated with one (1) new security camera. The differences between a low end and high end security camera include image quality, camera angle options, motion sensor capabilities, zoom ranges, as well as other features.
