MAYOR'S COMMISSION ON AGING:

Statement of Qualifications Chuck H. Conley

My leadership abilities and skills have been achieved by over 35 years in Law Enforcement. It started when I was a Senior Patrolman in the Military Police and led to the advancement of Chief Investigator with the Indiana Attorney General's Office to the position I now hold as Section Chief with the California Department of Health Care Services. I wanted to venture into all aspects of law enforcement to gain as much knowledge as I possibly could during my career.

a) In August 1974, I entered the Military and was assigned as a Military Police Officer. This was the beginning of my career in law enforcement. I ended my military service and became a Sheriff in Indiana. After attending the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy and 3 years of service, I moved to California. I then began California State Service. I first entered the Department of Corrections and was advanced to the Investigation Unit. I then transferred to the Department of Health Services Investigations Branch where I eventually was promoted to Supervising Special Investigator in San Bernardino to supervise a newly created unit in the Inland Empire. In my capacity as Supervising Special Investigator I was responsible for training newly hired investigators and the development of policies and procedures in the growing investigations branch.

Since the San Bernardino and Riverside area of the state had never been a focus of complaints, I was involved in the development and implementation of a multi-agency matrix. This matrix contained a breakdown of the types of complaints received and the process to determine the appropriate agency that had jurisdictional responsibility and authority to resolve the issue/complaint.

b) During my assignment as Supervising Investigator in the Inland Section I was responsible for coordinating the training and acting as liaison with allied agencies such as DOJ, Bureau of Medi-Cal Fraud, California Department of Social Services (Fraud Bureau), and local county and federal agencies.

- 1. In January 1988, I brought to the attention to the Investigative Branch the aspect of conducting "early fraud" sweeps to the out-stationed areas that were not routinely investigated for individuals that might not be eligible for Medi-Cal Aid. These areas were especially vulnerable to individuals not residing in California that were in fact obtaining aid from California. This program became so successful that it is now a part of the CDHCS routine function.
 - a) In addition to my regular duties as a Supervising Special Investigator, I developed relationships with the California Attorney Generals Office Bureau of Medi-Cal Fraud, Department of Drug Enforcement Agency, and began the first Drug Diversion Prescription Investigation Network (PDIN). This is now statewide. This joint agency effort attracted and generated positive publicity by the news media.
 - b) I also developed liaisons with the Riverside and San Bernardino Counties Departments of Social Services, District Attorneys Offices and established partnerships with the San Bernardino and Riverside County Police and Sheriff's Departments.
 - c) In 1989 while in my capacity as a Supervising Special Investigator, I was appointed as the first Supervising Range Master and wrote the first "Range Course" conducted by DHS Investigations after they were first issued departmental weapons.
- 2. In September of 1991 I transferred to the California Medical Board Fraud Investigations. I was assigned to the drug diversion unit and was selected to attend the California 11550 Drug Investigations Academy. I also received several letters of accommodations from my peers in regards to my case work. I had a very successful conviction rate with my cases, several of which were used in the training aspect for other investigators. I was appointed to the first investigators committee to reform the case work product and training programs within the department.
- 3. In June of 1993 I transferred to the California Department of Justice Bureau of Medi-Cal Fraud (CDJBMF). I was recruited by the Section Chief Chris Rodriguez to open the first field office in the Inland Empire. While there I was given high priority cases, one of which I was sent out of state to obtain information. This resulted in 3 criminal filings and the restitution of over \$350,000.00.

In January 1996, I was informed by San Martin, Chief Investigator with the CDJBMF, of an opening with the Indiana Attorney General's Office with the Medicaid Fraud Unit. Because of a family hardship I needed to return to Indiana to help with my mother's care. I applied for the Chief Investigator position and was selected.

My first year as Chief I worked with supervisory staff in Indianapolis and supervised the entire investigative state offices. I was also in charge of the entire investigative programs within the Attorney General's Office. I was to establish standards, accountability and improve production throughout the state. It was during this first year that I became aware of several problems the investigative unit had. The foremost was lack of training and equipment.

During my period of time as Chief in Indiana, I developed my skills as a Manager by enrolling in several management classes at the Indiana Law Enforcement Training Academy such as; "Frontline Leadership Seminars" and "White Collar Crime for Managers".

I developed working relationships with the United States Attorney General's Office, the Department of Social Services Agencies and Prosecutorial and Law Enforcement Agencies within the state.

As Chief, I created the first Indiana Law Enforcement Investigators Academy. This academy was based on investigations and was certified by the state legislators within the Law Enforcement Academy Training Program.

This Academy was needed for several reasons:

- A. No training existed within the state for the investigator class.
- B. When investigators were sent to the Basic Police Officer Training Academy, they could, and were more than likely, able to transfer to a Police Department after completing the 30 week academy.
- C. The academy would not sanction any training outside their existing programs.

I put together a detailed presentation of the reasons why the program was needed, but also the cost saving aspect (in regards to funding by State and Federal Agencies). I set guidelines and assured the Executive Academy Board, that the integrity of the Academy would not be tainted.

I was solely responsible for the entire curriculum and the logistics of the training program. Creating this academy was a very time consuming process and required a lot of legal research. It also required obtaining the funds from the State and Federal budgets.

I created the entire budget, coordinated with the Executive Academy Staff and the Attorney Generals Office. Because this training included the State Investigative Officers for the entire state, several funding programs were used.

The Academy was completed and the first class graduated in the fall of 1996. The academy is still being used by the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy today. I received an award from not only the Academy but the Indiana Attorney General Jeffery Modisett.

As Chief, I was involved in several program administrative issues within the Attorney General's Office. In the spring of 1997, Indiana was converting to the Managed Care System. This required several changes in the Medicaid Program for the state. I was in charge of establishing new investigative criteria for the AG's office. This entailed not only changes in the Medicaid fraud unit, but also how the state functioned in creating new laws and programs. This required not only the supervision of my staff in the fraud area, but the way the Managed Care Division responded to the needs of the state. This task gave me a challenge and the opportunity to broaden my leadership skills. The program was implemented in 1997.

When the Managed Care Program was implemented, there were some exemptions. My unit was asked to look into these exemptions to see if the possibility of fraud could be identified. After conducting a preliminary investigation and the use of data-mining the programs, we came up with several potential problems.

- a) Dental services was one that had a high risk of fraud potential. After conducting several investigations and undercover operations on cases that we identified, we obtained the most significant criminal prosecution of a dentist in the state's history.
- b) Transportation was another program that was identified as a high risk. After conducting several investigations and undercover operations on cases that we identified, we once again had the most significant criminal prosecution of a transportation company in the state's history.
- c) Chiropractors were also another program that was identified as a high risk. After conducting several investigations and undercover operations on cases that we identified, we again had the most significant criminal prosecution of any chiropractor business in the state's history. This case was highlighted on the television program 20/20 and our investigation undercover footage was used by the Attorney General during his interview. I received a "Letter of Accommodation" for this case.

As a result of our success in these cases and the use of our undercover procedures, I applied for a federal grant and obtained one for over a \$120,000.00 that was used to buy a surveillance van and undercover technical equipment. With the use of this equipment, we were able to reduce our time in conducting investigations and reduce our case loads.

This system of investigation was promoted by the United States Attorney General's Office which prosecuted our cases.

While in Indiana, I also managed a private security company. There I was in charge of managing the surveillance and body guard personnel of high profile individuals. This eventually became so lucrative that I had over 90 employees throughout the state and it became full-time employment for me. When I was hired by the state initially, they were going through a political change and I came to the realization that my appointment may be in jeopardy, so I decided to accept full-time employment with the security company.

In July of 1999 my mother's health deteriorated and she passed away (this was the reason why had we moved to Indiana). My daughter was still in California, finished college and had married. In 2000 my granddaughter was born and my wife, son and I decided to return to California.

In September of 2001 I returned to the California Department of Health Services Audits and Investigations Branch as an investigator. My first assignment was to organize the Managed Care Investigation Program. I contacted the assigned programs within the eastern region of the state. After organizing a pilot program with the Managed Care Compliance Units for case investigations, I was transferred to the Rancho Cucamonga Investigations Office. There I was assigned to conduct the first Managed Care Joint Investigations Program with the Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP).

This project was monumental in that it required mutual cooperation with the Managed Care Programs such as IEHP, Molina, Kaiser, and Health Net.

This assignment proved to be quite a challenge as I was required to identify the investigative needs of the Managed Care Programs and the authority /responsibility the Department of Health Services Investigation Branch had. There were different Health Care Programs that required constant interaction and meetings to establish appropriate protocol to insure the fraud complaints were identified.

I was also assigned to the Managed Care Advisory Board and presented numerous power-point presentations statewide regarding investigating and identifying fraud within the Managed Care Programs.

To accomplish this task I developed the Managed Care Fraud Investigators Training Program. This program was presented to the Chief of Investigations Bruce Edwards for review. I was then assigned to train the entire state Investigative Branch on Managed Care Investigations. For this I received the Sustained Superior Accomplishment Award in 2005. I also received a Certificate of Appreciation form the Managed Care Program.

This vast expansion of duties and responsibilities prepared me in the development of my multi-tasking skills which in turn has prepared me to accept a number of high profile assignments and to produce positive and successful results.

In October 2006, I was promoted to Section Chief in the West Region of the state, (Los Angeles area) for California Department of Health Services, Audits and Investigations Branch.

During my first year as Section Chief, I was given the responsibility of rebuilding the Section because it had not had a Section Chief for approximately 2 years. There were 2 supervisor vacancies and 10 investigator openings. A lot of things were in disarray. The first task was to rebuild the staff's morale and get the office back to a cohesive working environment.

My next goal was to organize the offices in my section as follows:

- a) Old files were archived, the file and evidence rooms were organized to obtain more storage space.
- b) Our dated equipment was surveyed.
- c) Confidential information was controlled to comply with the HIPAA Regulations.
- c) Organize the case loads and investigator assignments.
- d) I have completed the task of hiring 8 new investigators, one supervisor, and brought my training staff, such as firearm instructors & background investigators to accepted levels. We do internal training on a monthly basis, and our production has increased at all levels.

I have rebuilt the working relationships with the California Department of Justice Bureau of Medi-Cal Fraud and Patient Abuse Investigations, the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office, and the Local Law Enforcement Community.

Since I have been Section chief the West Region has received awards from the Los Angeles County District Attorneys Office, the Los Angeles County Sheriffs office, and the Department of Veterans Affairs Agency.

As Section Chief for the West Region I continually liaison with other allied agencies and can proudly profess that although my section has the least amount of staff, the production numbers are constantly the highest of the other three sections.

On July 1, 2010 I was appointed the In-Home Support Service Section Chief to the IHSS Los Angeles Task Force. As Section Chief, I received letters of accommodation from the Los Angeles District Attorney's office and the Los Angeles Department of Social Services. Our unit set a record of 206 criminal filings in one year.


