1. Citizen Participation

Rick Moslenko spoke about concerns regarding conflicts of interest, transparency, how the WA-Ag proposal v17 is being forced upon the Task Force, and that other proposals should be brought forth. He voiced concern about the biennial inspection charge, costs for a second meter, and the potential backflow device. Mary Humbolt spoke in regards to how many trees were in place as a result of the implementation of the WA-3 rate schedule, and as customers were transitioned off that rate how many trees began being cut down since customers could no longer afford to irrigate them. She discussed the advantages that trees bring to the City.

Chair Wilson reminded everyone of the Mission of the Task Force, to develop WA-3 and WA-9 rate recommendations for RPU Board and Council by July 1, 2019. Chair Wilson opened up discussion by going through the powerpoint page turn of the WA-Aq proposal v17 terms and conditions. Significant discussions followed as Chair Wilson walked through Slides 1 thru 9.

All of the following actions were taken on the WA-Ag v17 rate proposal.

Task Force agreed that:

- -The explicit biennial inspection charge should be removed from the proposal.
- -Regular inspections can primarily be done remotely using aerial photography and GIS applications.
- -Staff should rework language regarding inspection timeframes.

Member Hunter made a motion to combine parts A & B of the RATES section of the proposal and to drop part C of the RATES section of the proposal.
