SUBJECT: PRESENTATION OF WA-9 FLAT RATE PROPOSAL VERSION 2.1

ISSUE:

Review, discuss and file a presentation of the WA-9 Flat Rate proposal (v 2.1).

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force receive, discuss and file a presentation of the WA-9 Flat Rate proposal (v 2.1).

BACKGROUND:

The primary purpose of the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force (Task Force) is to formulate and develop an agricultural water rate proposal. To date, there have been three rate proposal concepts brought before the Task Force. The WA-9 Flat Rate (v2.1) proposal is based on the concept that there should only be one sole class of customers known as "Irrigators". This sole class of irrigators is differentiated into three groups based on the type of water service they receive, either non-potable Gage Canal water; recycled water, or potable water.

DISCUSSION:

Alternate Scott Simpson has developed this WA-9 Flat Rate proposal approach and will be presenting it to the Agricultural Water Rates Task Force.
