ISSUE:

Receive an overview presentation on the Riverside University Health System Behavioral Health Department.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

BACKGROUND:

Behavioral Health is part of Riverside University Health System (RUHS), which also includes the departments of Community Health Clinics, Public Health and the 439-bed medical center in Moreno Valley. RUHS Behavioral Health is comprised of three major programs - Mental Health Services, Substance Use Services, and the Public Guardian's Office - operating 50 clinic sites across the County, including three mental health urgent care centers and three transitional age youth centers. Dr. Matthew Chang, the Director of RUHS Behavioral Health, leads a dedicated professional team of approximately 2,000 employees consisting of psychiatrists, clinicians, peer specialists, and other professionals who serve over 60,000 people annually.
