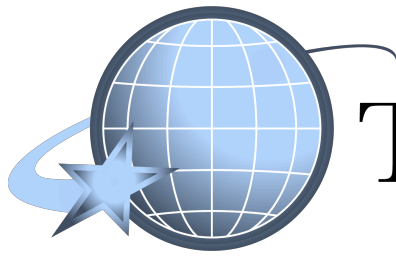
Born and raised in Southern California, Marc Troast brings years of political experience working with national, state and local government and campaigns.

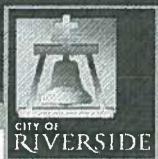

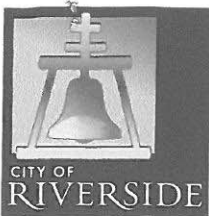


