SUBJECT: COMMISSION RESIGNATION

ISSUES:

Accept resignation of Carlos Delgado from the Budget Engagement Commission Ward 5 Business seat.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor and City Council:

1. Accept the resignation Carlos Delgado from the Budget Engagement Commission Ward 5 Business seat, effective immediately; and
2. Request the City Clerk to process the vacancy.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

On March 6, 2019, the City Clerk's Office received a resignation from Carlos Delgado of the Budget Engagement Commission, effective immediately. His term expires on March 1, 2021. Mr. Delgado held the Ward 5 Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission. The Budget Engagement Commission includes nine business members, seven nominated by each of the Council members to represent a business located in their respective City ward or an individual who resides in the respective City ward and has a business located elsewhere in the City. The vacancy created by this resignation will be filled by a registered voter in compliance with the Charter requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
