6. 2 Mini-maker Faires – approximately 200 attendees.



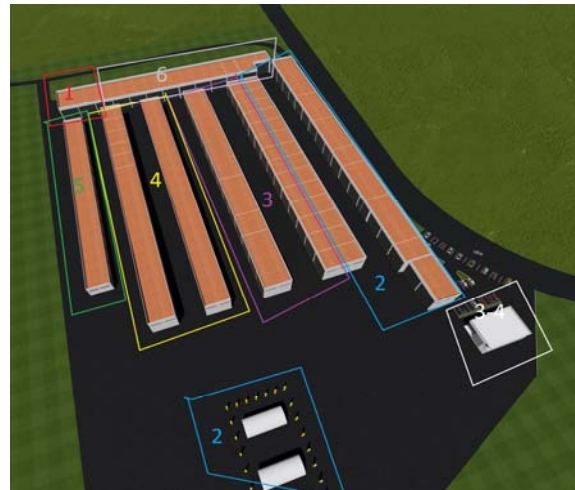
