## BACKGROUND

1. City's Animal Keeping Regulations:
a) Title 19 - Zoning: Land use regulations underCommunity \& Economic Development purview; and
b) Title 8 - Anima ls: Animal welfare under Public Works purview.
2. Disc repancies and lack of clarity;
3. Proposed amendments:
a) Resolve inconsistencies; and
b) Consider current land use trends.

## BACKGROUND

4. March 9, 2017 - Planning Commission Workshop:
a) Discussion on domestic and non-domestic animals; and
b) Commission input: Non-domestic animals appropriate for larger lots and agriculture areas.
5. May 8, 2017 - Land Use Committee (LUC) Workshop:
a) LUC Input similar to Planning Commission; and
b) Directed Staff to bring animals back to LUC/City Council.

## BACKGROUND

6. October, 2017 - AB 485 "Pet Rescue \& Adoption Act":
a) Retail stores cannot sell dogs, cats or rabbits unless from a public a nimal control agency or shelter; and
b) Because of Law - no need for retail sales restrictions or breeder lic ensing.
7. February 21, 2019 - Planning Commission recommended City Council approval and consideration of:
a) Temporary fostering of a nimals; and
b) Allow rabbits the same aspot-bellied pigs.

## DISC USSION - AMENDMENTS

Modify Allowed Zones for Domestic Animals

1. Redefine non-domestic animals-adding rabbits, poultry, pigeons and turkeys; and
2. Allow domestic animals in all zones.

## DISC USSION - AMENDMENIS

## Eliminate Redundancies for Permitted Non-Domestic Animals in the RA-5 and RC Zones

1. Chapter 19.100.030 - permitted uses in RA-5 and RC zones:
a) Allows non-domestic a nimals \& lists a nimal keeping sta ndards;
b) Duplic a tes stand ards in Chapter 19.455 - Animal Keeping.
2. Proposed Amendments:
a) C ha pter 19.100.030 eliminates redundancies.

## DISCUSSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued)

Clarify Definitions for Kennels and Catteries

1. Addressed in both (Title 19 \& Title 8);
2. Proposed Amendments:
a)Defines "Kennel-Commercial", "Kennel-Residential", "Cattery-Commercial" and "Cattery-Residential";
b) Title 8 Refers to Title 19; and
c) Definition for "Boarding of Animals" addressed in the Kennel definitions.

## DISCUSSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued)

## Beekeeping

1. Limited to RR, RA-5 \& RC zones:
a) Substantial setback requirements; and
b) Regulations mirror County Department of Environmental Health.
2. Proposed Amendments - No changes proposed to the current regulations.

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## DISCUSSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued)

Homing Pigeons (aka, Racing Pigeons)

1. Pigeons - non-domestic a nimals allowed in RR, RA-5, \& RC zones; and
2. Proposed Amendments:
a) Homing pigeons permitted in RR, RA-5, RC zones;
b) Homing pigeons require Minor CUP in R-1 and RE zones;
c) Min. lot size 20,000 sf;
d) Max. $\underline{25}$ on lots less than 1-acre and $5 \underline{0}$ on 1-acre or greater;
e) Hobby pigeons must be registered; and
f) Other requirements for coops/lofts, sealed feed containers.

## DISC USSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued) Poultry and Crowing Fowl

1. Currently only a llowed in RR, RA-5 \& RC zones:
a) Currently non-domestic animals; and
b) Pre-2007 Zoning Code; non-domestic animals allowed in R-1 zones.
2. Proposed Amendments:
a) Allow Non-Domestic Animals in R-1 \& RE zones;
b) No more than five poultry (any combination of chickens, turkeys, ducks or geese) on lots 20,000 square feet or larger;
c) Turkeys specific ally added to definition of "crowing fowl"; and
d) Poultry, ducks, geese \& turkeys housed 50 feet away from any dwelling.

## DISC USSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued) Temporary Use of Grazing Goats for Weed Abatement

1. Weed Management - Eco-friendly \& effective for fire haza rd areas;
2. Proposed Amendments:
a) Allow in all zones subject to a Minor Temporary Use Permit;
b) Max. of 20 continuous days per TUP, per site;
c) Max. of 3 occurrences per calendaryear (60 days total);
d) Min. one-acre undeveloped land area - Max. 75 goats per acre;
e) Goats in a secure enclosure (temporary fencing \& shelter);
f) Constant supply of fresh water;
g) Goats managed \& monitored 24 hrs./day; and
h) Required cleaning \& maintenance of conta inment areas.

## DISC USSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued)

## Planning Commission Recommendation

1. Rabbits-Proposed amendment:
a) Allow max. two
(2) rabbits in all Single-Fa mily Residential zones; and
b) Rabbits housed 25 feet a way from any dwelling.
2. Fostering (dogs, cats, rabbits, and birds):
a) Titles $8 \& 19$ do not define or address fostering;
b) Proposed Amendments:
i. Define Animal Foster and Animal Foster Organization;
ii. Allow fostering max. 6 months within 18 month period;
iii. Allow one foster animal in addition to max. number of a nimals; and
iv. Evidence of Animal foster a greement with animal foster organiza tionn.

## DISCUSSION - AMENDMENTS (Continued)

## Virulent Newcaste Disease

1. Impacts birds a nd poultry;
2. Near 100\% morta lity;
3. Recent qua ra ntine in Riverside County; a nd
4. Proposed Amendment allows poultry in all residential zones (development sta ndards).

## RECOMMENDATIONS

That the City Council:

1. DEIERMINE that Planning Case P19-0056 Riverside Municipal

Code Amendment is exempt from the provisions of the CEQA per Section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense Exemption);
2. APPROVE Pla nning C ase P19-0056 Riverside Munic ipal C ode Amendment based on the findings of the Planning Commission staff report; and
3. INIRODUCE and subsequently ADOPT an Ordinance a mending the Animal Keeping provisions of Title 19-Zoning Code and Title 8 - Animals, of the Riverside Munic ipal Code.
