ISSUES:

Accept resignations of Bergis K. Jules and Debra L. Whitney from the Metropolitan Museum Board Citywide and Ward 4 seats, respectively.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor and City Council:

- 1. Accept the resignations of Bergis K. Jules and Debra L. Whitney from the Metropolitan Museum Board Citywide and Ward 4 seats, effective immediately; and
- 2. Request the City Clerk to process the vacancies.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

On February 25, 2019, and March 14, 2019, the City Clerk's Office received resignations from Bergis K. Jules and Debra L. Whitney of the Metropolitan Museum Board, effective immediately. Mr. Jules held the Citywide seat and Ms. Whitney held the Ward 4 seat with terms ending on March 1, 2020.

The vacancies created by the resignations of Mr. Jules and Ms. Whitney will be filled by registered voters in compliance with the Charter requirement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
