REVISION OF TIMED PARKING ZONE – ABERNATHY DRIVE AND FAIR ISLE DRIVE

Following discussion motion was made by Member Bullock and seconded by Member Martin recommending that the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve the parking zone revision on the west side of Fair Isle Drive from Lockerton Lane to Abernathy Drive and Abernathy Drive on the park frontage to change the zone duration from “No Parking between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.” to “No Parking between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.”

Motion carried unanimously.

ALLEY BETWEEN MISSION INN AND UNIVERSITY AVENUES AND ORANGE STREET AND THE MAIN STREET PEDESTRIAN MALL – CONVERSION OF PORTION TO ONE-WAY TRAVEL

ROYAL PALM BOULEVARD - ESTABLISHMENT OF TIMED NO PARKING ZONE

Following discussion motion was made by Vice Chair Armas and seconded by Member Brown recommending that the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve establishment of a “No Parking between the hours of 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. daily” zone along the entirety of the cul-de-sac at the southwesterly termination of Royal Palm Boulevard.

Motion carried unanimously.
