

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,
3 (1) APPROVING AND ESTABLISHING REVISED ELECTRIC RULE 6 AND
4 WATER RULE 6, EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION; AND (2) MAKING
5 RELATED FINDINGS OF FACT

6 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside (“City”) by and through its Public Utilities Department
7 (“RPU”) is obligated to: (1) serve its water and electric customers safe, reliable and equitably
8 priced water and electricity; (2) operate its Electric and Water Utilities in an efficient and
9 economical manner; and (3) operate, maintain and preserve its Electric and Water Utilities in good
10 repair and working order; and

11 WHEREAS, RPU is responsible for operating the Electric and Water Utilities in such a
12 manner that revenues from the sale of electric and water shall at least equal the costs of operation,
13 including all maintenance and operating, administrative and general, debt service, capital
14 improvements, tax-related payments and other costs incurred in complying with prudent utility
15 business practices; and

16 WHEREAS, Department staff submitted to the City's Board of Public Utilities (“Board”) proposed revisions to Electric Rule 6 and Water Rule 6; and

17 WHEREAS, the Board conducted a duly noticed public hearing on March 11, 2019,
18 regarding the proposed revisions to Electric Rule 6 and Water Rule 6; and

19 WHEREAS, after considering all staff and public comment thereon, on March 11, 2019,
20 the Board adopted and established the proposed revisions to Electric Rule 6 and Water Rule 6, all
21 to be effective upon approval by the City Council.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED:

23 Section 1: That the findings of fact of the Board of Public Utilities made in its Resolution
24 No. 2019-01, which Resolution is attached hereto as Attachment 1 and incorporated herein in its
25 entirety by this reference, are hereby adopted as findings of the City Council.

26 Section 2: That the Public Utilities Department is directed to prepare and file the Notice
27 of Exemption and such other documents as are required by the California Environmental Quality
28 Act (Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.) in connection with the proposed rule revisions.
