Item 6 Recurring Update of the New Main Library

Library Director Christmas indicated that over 150 people attended the groundbreaking ceremony on March 18. Fairmount Blvd. has been closed off at the site. Time-lapse cameras at the construction site are being used to capture photos of the progress for future reporting. Next steps include a public hearing on May 21, 2019, at 3 p.m. in the City Council Chambers for the bond financing component of this project. Trustee's attendance at the public hearing is not required but optional.

Item 7 Recurring Update of Specialist Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library

Library Director Christmas reported on April 9, 2019 at 7 p.m. the City Council will discuss the SPC. Jesus S. Duran Eastside Library site selection and request to use Measure Z funds in the amount of \$100,000 designated for site selection and allocate the total Measure Z funds for architecture firm selected through a Request for Proposal process to provide Phase 1 architectural design services. Library Director Christmas encouraged Trustees to attend.
