SUBJECT: LIBRARY DEPARTMENT RECOGNITION

ISSUE:

Receive a report on the City Council recognition of the Library Department.

RECOMMENDATION:

BACKGROUND:

On April 16, the City Council is scheduled to receive an overview of the Library Department and recognize the Department's employees.

The month of April was selected to coincide with National Library Week, which is April 7-13, 2019. National Library Week is a time to celebrate libraries, librarians and library workers and the work they do every day to meet the specific and diverse needs of their communities. The theme for National Library Week 2019 is Libraries = Strong Communities. Libraries = Strong Communities is also the theme of the American Library Association's new public awareness campaign which is designed to increase public awareness of the value, impact and services provided by libraries and library professionals.

Libraries = Strong Communities recognizes many key facts, including that (a) Today's libraries are not just about what libraries have for people, but what libraries do for and with people; (b) Libraries are evolving with the changes in the information landscape and the skills and tools needed to thrive in our digital world; (c) Libraries are committed to advancing their legacy of reading and developing a digitally inclusive society; and (d) Libraries add value in five key areas: education, employment, entrepreneurship, empowerment and engagement.
