    - Review the CIP pursuant to Gov't Code Section 65401
  - California Gov't Code Sec. 65401
    - Requires annual CIP program review by Planning Commission

## **Biennial Budget Program**

- Two Year Budget
  - Fiscal year 2018/2019 through 2019/2020
  - Two-Year CIP
  - Essential Services and Infrastructure



- 5 Year Capital Improvement Plan
  - Helps prioritize capital expenditures
  - Identifies longer-term fiscal challenges

- March 22, 2018 Planning Commission reviewed projects and determined General Plan 2025 consistency
  - FY 2018/19 2019/20 Budget
  - FY 2018/19 2019/20 CIP
- Current Review
  - Mid-year budget & CIP revisions
  - 33 projects for FY 2019/2020 not■ previously considered

#### Recommendations

That the Planning Commission:

- **DETERMINE** that the review of the City of Riverside's capital improvement projects for FY 2019/20 (PSP19-0033) is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) because the review is not considered a "project" as defined by section 15378(b)(4), and a determination of consistency by the Planning Commission has no potential to result in a direct or indirect physical change in the environment.
- **FIND** that the capital improvement projects added to the two-year budget for FY 2019/20 are consistent with General Plan 2025; and
- **REPORT to the City Council** that the capital improvement projects for FY 2019/20, including any revisions to the two-year Capital Improvement Program (FY 2018/2020 through FY 2019/2020), are consistent with General Plan 2025.
