**SUBJECT: BUDGET ENGAGEMENT COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS**

## **ISSUE:**

Appoint Reginald L. Kyles and Andrew C. Walcker to the Wards 4 and 5 Business seats, respectively, on the Budget Engagement Commission.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That the Mayor and City Council appoint:

1. Reginald L. Kyles to the Ward 4 Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission for a term ending March 1, 2023; and
2. Andrew C. Walcker to the Ward 5 Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission for a term ending March 1, 2021.

## **BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:**

The Budget Engagement Commission advises the City Council on spending and policy priorities based on the information received through financial and performance reports. The eighteen-member Commission is comprised of (1) nine resident members, seven nominated by each of the Council members to represent each of the City's wards, and two Citywide nominations made by the Mayor; and (2) nine business members, seven nominated by each of the Council members to represent a business located in their respective City ward or an individual who resides in the respective City ward and who has a business located in any way in the City, and two Citywide nominations made by the Mayor.

Councilmember Conder recommends appointment of Reginald L. Kyles to the Ward 4 Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission for a term ending March 1, 2023.

Councilmember Mac Arthur recommends appointment of Andrew C. Walcker to the Ward 5 Business seat on the Budget Engagement Commission to fill an unexpired term through March 1, 2021. This vacancy was created by the resignation of Carlos Delgado. Mr. Walcker currently serves on the Board of Public Utilities and will serve on both boards simultaneously.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Recruitment and appointment costs are included annually in the City Clerk's budget.
