SUBJECT: COMMUNITY POLICE REVIEW COMMISSION WARD 1 VACANCY

ISSUE:

Select applicants for interview for the Community Police Review Commission Ward 1 seat.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee:

- 1. Review Community Police Review Commission applications for Ward 1 and select those for interview to fill vacancy through March 1, 2023; and
- 2. Direct the City Clerk to schedule interviews with the Mayor and Councilmembers to add additional names for interview, if desired.

BACKGROUND:

On March 27, 2019, the City Clerk received the resignation of Keith P. Sklarsky from the Ward 1 seat on the Community Police Review Commission effective immediately. Mr. Sklarsky's term will expire on March 1, 2023. There are 16 applications on file for the Ward 1 seat.

Pursuant to the City Council Meeting Rules, the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee reviews the applications and selects those for interview with the Mayor and City Council as individuals to add additional names for interview, if desired.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Costs for recruitment and selection of board and commission members are budgeted annually in the City Clerk's Department budget.
