What is the Adopt-A-Park program?

What can I do for my "adopted park?"

Three easy steps to Adopt-A-Park



Adopt-A-Park is a program sponsored by the City of Riverside Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to enhance the condition and quality of our parks through sponsorships and volunteer service.

Adopt-A-Park offers individuals, groups, organizations and businesses the opportunity to take an active role in the beautification of our community and help support the city's park system. The investment you make in your neighborhood is truly an investment in your own property.

The Adopt-A-Park agreement is for one year and is renewable at the end of the sponsorship period. You may participate with an organization to clean and beautify your adopted area, donate amenities or sponsor major projects.

If your organization is involved in improvements sponsorship, you may:

1. Pick up litter and debris.
2. Clean and paint buildings, other designated structures, or equipment.
3. Remove graffiti.
4. Plant trees or shrubs and/or maintain the adopted area with assistance from the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department.

If you are involved in donations or sponsorship for major projects, you may:

1. Purchase or install park amenities (park benches, BBQs, and picnic tables).
2. Sponsor the cost of maintenance for your adopted park.
3. Cover the cost of a large-scale project (athletic field lighting, playground equipment).



1. Choose a park to adopt.

2. Select the type of adoption from the following:

- Improvements Sponsorship
- Donations Sponsorship
- Major Projects Sponsorship

3. Submit an application to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department. Applications are available in the Adopt-A-Park handbook, at your local community center or online at RivReg.org.
