When I was 8 years old, I was in a terrible car wreck where I lost my hearing on both sides and became partially paralyzed in my right leg. I also lost my Mother that day. It was a long road to recovery. I have worked my way out, from RSP, into the general education setting and now, I am in AP coursework. This has been an exciting year for me as I have won the National Council for Exceptional Children's Yes I Can! Award in the area of Technology and got to travel to Indianapolis to receive my award. I was recently named one of Riverside's 25 Most Remarkable Teens, and in June I will be honored in Rochester, NY as the Hearing Loss Association of America's Outstanding Youth! Which brings me to why I am applying for this award. I can't go without your help. You are an organization that encourages education and that's what I am trying to pursue.

If I were to win one of these two amazing and thoughtful prizes, it will help me a lot this summer. I was nominated and selected to be the HLAA outstanding young adult (Hearing Loss Association of America). This is really an honor to be selected will be a great learning opportunity for me, since I will be able to take advantage of the amazing workshops that they will have at this convention. HLAA has given me a free registration ticket! They will have programs that explain to me, and show me, many amazing tools that are available to help and, and other people like me, with a hearing loss. As an example, when I am at school or in an airport and the announcer is talking over a speaker, it is hard to hear them clearly when wearing hearing aids. At this workshop they have a presentation that will show and explain how I can fix this problem through the use of additional technology. However it doesn't stop there, since the convention is featuring 10 workshops with programs and presentations specializing in technology. This will be a huge benefit for me because when I'm in college my goal is to major in the area of technology. There's this one workshop that will help me know what to do when I can't understand or hear everything. They will teach me and show me all about captioning. This captioning app can help me when I'm on the phone and can't understand, or when I can't fully hear everything.

Winning this prize will help cover the costs of getting to NY. My Dad can't really afford to pay for my hotel or flight. I really am hoping to find enough funding for the both of us to attend. I really want my Dad there.

I have been really trying hard to fund the trip to receive my award. The estimate cost of the trip will be about \$2000, of which I have earned \$500 from the Rocky and Ahme Stone scholarship. Riverside County Office of Education has hired me to present at their banquet and I will be earning \$300 from that. I'm still hopeful that I will be able to cover all my costs.

It really brought my family and myself so much joy when I was nominated and selected to get an award. It really brought us closer together. This also makes me very happy because I know that if my mother was still here, she would be very proud of me, knowing that I have accomplished many amazing things that other people said I would never be able to complete.
