This will include academic and social growth into the new school year with various activities. Some of the activities would be, but are not limited to, drum circle, arts and crafts, dancing, poetry, and yoga.

We also have a academic component which will assist the students in avoiding academic regression outside of the school year. Focusing on math, reading, and science. We're also going to show them health, wellness, and the importance of good nutrition and living a healthy life. Another component we wanted to add are workshop sessions where the students will be able to work on their public speaking skills, communication, dispute resolution options, early financial literacy, social media conduct, and we would also have weekly speakers that would cover some of these topics. We are currently looking for sponsors for the students that qualify for a subsidized income program, with hopes of being able to provide this program at no out-of-pocket cost to the students involved. The dues would take care of day-to-day operations, supplies, stipends, and food. We missed the deadline to become state sponsored for Summer Meals; however, we are still working with other sponsoring organizations, but may need a site. If not, we would be able to still have meals through student dues, donations, and sponsorships. We will have a pre-and post questionnaire and assessment review to better gauge the outcome of our students. At the conclusion of the program we will have a culminating celebration.
