A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA TRANSFERRING 1.02 ACRES OF VACANT LAND LOCATED ON THE NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN LINE OF CHASE ROAD, KNOWN AS RIVERSIDE WATER COMPANY LOWER CANAL, ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NUMBERS 246-220-011 & 246-230-013 FROM RIVERSIDE PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT – WATER DIVISION TO THE COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTHSIDE HERITAGE MEADOWS URBAN GREENING GRANT PROJECT

8 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside Public Utilities Department's acquisition of the Riverside

Canal in 1961 includes ownership of adjacent canal parcels of land. Approximately 95% of the canal parcels are undevelopable and range between 25 and 66 feet in width and between .01 to 2.0 acres in size. The two canal parcels proposed to be transferred from the Public Utilities Department to the Community & Economic Development Department have not been actively used since 1914. The Public Utilities Department will retain the rights for waterline and canal facilities should they become necessary in the future.

WHEREAS, in April 2018, the City of Riverside submitted a competitive project proposal, referred to as the Northside Heritage Meadows Urban Greening Grant Project, to the 2018 Urban Greening Grant seeking \$3,937,069 to fund an urban greening project in the Northside neighborhood. The project includes the use of the two parcels controlled by RPU (APNs 246-220-011 and 246-230-013), hereinafter the "Property", and would be used for an urban greening project with multiple elements including: 1) construction of two (2) trails of approximately 0.5 miles in distance to increase neighborhood walkability and access to the project site; 2) planting of 453 trees and shrubs to provide shade, sequester carbon, support workforce training, and produce food; 3) establishment a 24-plot community garden to build a greater sense of community and increase food access; 4) installation of water and utility infrastructure to support project site activities; 5) preservation of 3.5 acres of green open space in agricultural activities thereby mitigating heat-island effects; and 6) funding of outreach activities to build strong community engagement in the project; and

WHEREAS, the two parcels identified as APNs 246-220-011 and 246-230-013 are described and depicted in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and
