ISSUE:

Adopt a Resolution establishing the 2019/20 Appropriations Limit of \$346,486,086 as required by Article XIIIB of the State Constitution.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt a Resolution establishing the 2019/20 Appropriations Limit of \$346,486,086 as required by Article XIIIB of the State Constitution.

BACKGROUND:

An annual appropriations limit established by City Council Resolution is required as a result of the 1979 Proposition 4, Gann Initiative, Article XIIIB of the State Constitution and Section 7910 of the Government Code.

DISCUSSION:

The appropriations limit for the City of Riverside is calculated to be \$346,486,086 for Fiscal Year 2019/20. Documentation showing the calculations made to arrive at the appropriations limit has been available in the Finance Department for review by the public for at least 15 days.

There is no fiscal impact associated with this report.
