

FIRST AMENDMENT

TO AGREEMENT FOR THE YOUTH SPORTS OFFICIALS AND SCOREKEEPERS

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR THE YOUTH SPORTS OFFICIALS AND SCOREKEEPERS ("First Amendment") is made and entered into this ~~32~~²⁹th day of ~~July~~^{August} 2018, by and between the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a California charter city and municipal corporation ("City"), and DANNY FULLER, a sole proprietor doing business as SPORTS INNOVATORS ("Contractor").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on or about July 26, 2016, City and Contractor entered into an Agreement for Contractor to furnish qualified sports officials and scorekeepers necessary for Youth Sports Programs and those other related services as set forth in Exhibit A of the Agreement ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, City is satisfied with the performance of Contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement will expire on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor desire to extend the Term of the Agreement for a period of one year to expire on June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor have agreed the amount of compensation as stated in Section 4 of the Agreement will be amended to an amount not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals which are incorporated herein by this reference, City and Contractor agree as follows:

1. The Term of the Agreement is hereby extended by a period of one year only from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

2. Compensation of the Agreement is hereby amended to an amount not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) per year.


3. All terms and conditions of the Agreement not inconsistent with this First Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated herein by this reference as though set forth in full.

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
