Starting Blocks



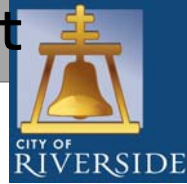
- Learn to Swim program - Partnership between Tilden-Coil, RUSD, RCCD

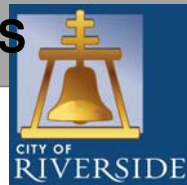
