

SECOND AMENDMENT TO WUNDERLICH-MALEC AGREEMENT FOR DISTRIBUTED CONTROL SYSTEM SERVICES AT RERC AND SPRINGS FOR \$180,000

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BACKGROUND

Riverside Energy Resource Center (RERC) and Springs Power Plant


- a. Wunderlich-Malec designed and commissioned DCS systems
- b. Customized to fit our process

2. Distributive Control System

- a. Integration of numerous plant equipment with central interface for technician
- b. Complex structure requires technical expertise and specific knowledge
- c. Essential for reliable plant operations

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DISCUSSION

- Single source procurement for remote and onsite services
- 2. Professional consultant services agreement and annual open purchase order for \$45,000 issued in Sept. 2017, expired in Sept. 2018
- 3. First Amendment extends agreement to July 2019
- 4. Negotiated fixed labor rates for 3 years
- 5. Second Amendment extends agreement to July 2022

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RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board of Public Utilities:

- 1. Approve the Second Amendment to the Professional Consultant Services Agreement with Wunderlich-Malec Engineering, Inc., of Gilbert, Arizona, for power plant control system engineering and consulting services at the Riverside Energy Resource Center and Springs Power Plant for a term ending July 1, 2022 in the amount of \$180,000 for a total agreement amount of \$270,000; and
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the Second Amendment to the Professional Consultant Services Agreement with Wunderlich-Malec Engineering, Inc., including the ability to make non-substantive changes.

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
