## **BACKGROUND**

- 1. SHARE Established in 1989
  - a. Originally funded from direct customer contributions
- 2. May 22, 2018: City Council Approved Enhancement
  - a. Expanded to 200% of the Federal Poverty Level
  - b. \$14.00 per month electric bill credit (up to \$168 per year)
  - c. \$2.25 per month water bill credit (up to \$27 per year)
  - d. Five (5) one-year automatic renewal periods
  - e. Funding: \$2.95 million
    - i. \$2,550,000 Electric customer assistance
    - ii. \$ 150,000 Water customer assistance
    - iii. \$ 250,000 County Administration fee

## DISCUSSION

#### 1. Enhanced Low-Income Programs

a. Rate plan commitment to increase with annual rate increases

#### 2. Increase Water Monthly Credit

- a. The next water rate increase scheduled for July 1, 2019
- b. Increase water monthly credit from \$2.25 to \$2.50 (up to \$30 per year, 7% increase)

#### 3. Increase Electric Monthly Credit

- a. Next electric rate increase scheduled for January 1, 2020
- b. Increase electric monthly credit from \$14.00 to \$14.50 (up to \$174 per year, 4% increase)

## 4. Expand Program Eligibility

- a. Proof of benefits from public assistance programs including:
  - i. Bureau of Indian Affairs General Assistance
  - ii. CalFresh/SNAP (Food Stamps)
  - iii. CalWorks (TANF)/Tribal TANF
  - iv. Head Start Income Eligible (Tribal Only)
  - v. LIHEAP
  - vi. Medi-Cal/Medicaid
  - vii. Medi-Cal for Families (Healthy Families A&B)
  - viii. National School Lunch Program (NSLP)
  - ix. Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
  - x. WIC

That the City Council approve an increase of the Sharing Households Assist Riverside's Energy Program's Electric Monthly Credit from \$14.00 to \$14.50 and Water Monthly Credit from \$2.25 to \$2.50 to align with electric and water rate increases for Fiscal Year 2019/20.
