18 19	that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment	
20	nor have a significant impact on the environment.	
21	Section 8: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause publication	
22	once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter of the City	
23	of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
